WHAT IS GBIF?

A network of people and research infrastructure aimed at providing anyone, anywhere, open access to data about all types of life on Earth.








MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING (MOU)

- Non-binding agreement signed by all Participants
- Establishes principles of open data sharing
- Sets out governance arrangements





THE GBIF INVESTMENT



Global (funding from voting participants, supplementary grants):

- Technical infrastructure, data indexing, GBIF.org, API
- Documentation and guidance, training, capacity enhancement
- Collaboration and governance

National (funding from ministries, research councils etc.):

- Coordination of national biodiversity information facilities (nodes)
- Stakeholder engagement, training, workshops
- Technical support for data management and publication
- National data discovery platforms, supporting applications in research and policy







Institutional (funding from institutional budgets, grants):

- Digitization of collections
- Data management skills and IT capacity
- Data analysis, research applications, publication


