Introduction

In the framework of the “Biodiversity Information for Development (BID)” program, several projects have been granted to research teams in Benin. The BID program funded by The European Union, aims at building the capacity and biodiversity data mobilization, so as to address health and food security challenges in Africa. The grants awarded to research teams include a national project (BID National) and a regional project (BID regional). In the framework of these projects, an information and planning meeting took place on June 14, 2016 at Sainte Anouarite Conference Centre in Abomey-Calavi. This meeting aimed at presenting both BID projects (BID National and BID Regional) and planning the various activities scheduled over time.

A total of 19 people attended the meeting. These participants were representatives of the institutions members of the projects at national level. The agenda of the meeting and participants list are presented as appendices 1 and 2, respectively.

The meeting started with the presentation of the agenda by the facilitator, Dr Augustin Aoudji. The meeting went through the following steps:

- welcome address of the Coordinator of “BID National” and “BID Regional” projects;
- presentation of the “BID National” project;
- presentation of the “BID Regional” project;
- planning of the national and regional projects’ activities;
- workshop closing.

These minutes summarizes the outcomes of the various steps of the meeting.

1. Welcome address of the Coordinator of BID national and regional projects

Professor Jean C. GANGLO, Coordinator of BID national and regional projects, in his opening address, welcomed all participants. On behalf of the Dean of the Faculty of Agricultural Sciences, he thanked the participants for their collaboration. He also thanked Dr Gaston Akouehou (head of delegation of GBIF-Benin) and Dr. Augustin Aoudji (member of GBIF-Benin) for their administrative support in the implementation of GBIF-Benin’s activities, and the development of this network. Before launching the workshop, he transmitted the encouragements words from Dean of the FSA for full success throughout the workshop. He highlighted that the project were fund by the European Union (EU) in the framework of Biodiversity Information for Development (BID) program managed by the

Secretariat of the Global Biodiversity Information Facility (GBIFS). He warmly thank the EU, the BID program, and the GBIFS.

2. Presentation of the BID national project

The presentation of the BID National project was done by Professor Jean C. Ganglo, Coordinator and node manager of GBIF-Benin. Prof. Ganglo began his presentation by highlighting the importance of biodiversity, and the challenges around its sustainable preservation. He demonstrated that addressing these challenges will require capacity building in data mobilization and data use.

Then the objectives of BID national project were presented, as follows:

(1) to build the capacities of national services on the importance of the biodiversity:

In this framework, it is scheduled to identify the priority medicinal species that cure malaria and multipurpose agro-forestry species. Workshops will be organized to build partners' capacities, to enable them to mobilize more data. These data will be retrieved from databases in Benin for digitizing and publication. Data will be also mobilized from overseas institutions, namely in France, the Netherlands, and Belgium.

(2) to enhance data availability:

This will be done by providing technical and financial assistance to various partners for the digitalization of their data. The mobilization of these data will result in a check-list that will be published on the GBIF and GBIF-Benin's websites.

(3) to use biodiversity data to address national priorities:

Distribution maps of species will be elaborated. This will enable to figure out the relevant strategies for the conservation and use of these species. Another activity will consist of verifying whether protected areas will be able to contribute effectively to the conservation of priority species, today and in the future, given the context of climate change. This might result in suggestions of their extension for increased effectiveness. Deliverables will be disseminated through communications via various media, to show to policy makers that the biodiversity data value chain is a source of knowledge. The application of this knowledge brings solution to biodiversity issues.

The following point of the presentation was the project's logical framework that connects results, activities and indicators. The biodiversity data mobilization plan was also presented.

Contributing institutions and the expected quantity of data to supply were presented. These institutions are members of the project consortium, namely the Laboratory of Forest Sciences, the Center of Forestry Studies, Research and training, the National Herbarium, the University of Agriculture of Kétou, Nature Tropicale NGO, the General Direction of Forests and Natural Resources, etc. Last, the project's budget was presented (30000€), with the sharing per work package.

At the end of the presentation, participants unanimously congratulated the Coordinator for his dynamism and the investment in the promotion of biodiversity informatics in Benin. It was suggested that members of the project team be appointed to support the coordinator in the monitoring of activities, so as to ensure timely delivery of outcomes. The debates gave opportunity to the coordinator to talk about the duration of the project that is 2 years (From June 1st, 2016 to May 31st, 2018).

3. Presentation of the BID regional project

The project entitled "Capacity building and biodiversity data mobilization for conservation, sustainable use, and decision making in Africa and Madagascar" has been submitted in consortium by 8 French-speaking countries of Africa (Benin, Senegal, Côte d'Ivoire, Mali, Guinea, Democratic Republic of Congo, Madagascar, and Niger). Professor Jean C. Ganglo underlined the importance of biodiversity to the survival of humanity, and threats it has been facing. The objectives of the project are:

(1) to establish and strengthen international collaboration to mobilize biodiversity data:

Invasive alien species and endangered species will be identified. This will be done based on references lists of species of each country. Workshops will be organized at the regional level under the mentorship of the University of Kansas, in order to improve the skills of consortium members. This will enable to digitalize data from partner countries. In addition, data available in overseas institutions (museum in France, in Netherlands, and in Belgium) will be exploited.

(2) to increase available biodiversity data during and beyond the grant period:

This will be done by strengthening capacities of partners in the various countries members of the consortium, by giving technical and financial supports for data publishing on GBIF's website.

(3) to apply biodiversity data in response to conservation priorities:

The achievement of this objective will require statistical data on endangered and invasive species. The following stage is the identification of various threats on these species and strategies to control and to reduce invasive species. This will contribute to biodiversity conservation of the targeted species. Deliverables will be broadcasted through communications via diverse media, to show policy makers and natural resources managers that biodiversity data value chain provides useful knowledge, to address issues related to natural resources conservation.

The Professor Jean C. GANGLO presented the logical framework of the BID Regional project. The mobilization data will be done with contributions of national partners in each country. As far as Benin is concerned, the institutions are: Laboratory Forest Sciences, the Project "*10000000 d'âmes, 10000000 d'arbres*", the Centre for Forestry Studies, Research and training, Nature Tropicale NGO, etc.

Regarding the budget, each country has an amount of 20000 Euros. Benin will receive an additional amount of 5000 Euros for the Coordinator's activities in member countries of the consortium, hence a 25000 Euros budget for Benin.

4. Planning of BID national and regional projects' activities

The results of the activity planning of the projects are respectively in appendices 3 ad 4 for national and regional project.

5. Workshop Closing

At the end of the meeting, the facilitator made a summary of various activities carried out. Then, Professor Jean C. GANGLO, Coordinator of BID National and Regional projects thanked all organizers and participants. He invited each participant to stay committed for the respect of the planning of activities of both projects.

Conclusion

The objectives of the workshop on information and planning of BID National and Regional projects (June 14, 2016) were reached. Participants committed themselves to do the best for the success of both projects. The activities of BID National and Regional projects were planned. To this end, work teams have been formed and given specific assignments for various activities of the two projects.
