# 3. Overview of results

# 3.1. Executive summary

The project titled "Developing an Accessible Biodiversity Information System for Sustainable Development in Cameroon" aims to strengthen the mobilization of biodiversity data by (i) promoting the establishment of a nodal structure in Cameroon; (ii) Setting up a network of data manager (organizations and individuals); (iii) to facilitate the signature of the GBIF Agreement in Cameroon (iv) to make available data on Fresh water Aquatic Plants medicinal plants and certain species of Raphiales at the international level .

#### 1. Establishment of a nodal point in Cameroon

This first activity was triggered by numerous advocacy activities and information's at the level of Ministries. The information center has been designated as the structure to host the nodal point but for its full implementation it should involve two elements: (i) the signature of a MOU and the availability of the resources mobilization and financing document which should allow its full implementation .

The capacity building activities were carried out by: (i) The purchase of a laptop for the Data manager in charge of data publications and the availability of a secure and high speed internet connection (ii).

#### 2. The establishment of a network of data holders on biodiversity in Cameroon.

A network of data holders has been developed and two other activities will be needed to finalize this objective:







- Identification and evaluation of available data;
- Strengthening the data holders' capacities to publish and make available data near the nodal
- The development of a data sharing chart to which each member of the network should adhere as well as designing the tools(Data sharing sheets and guides). These tools are being finalized and should be shared and adopted during the network implementation Workshop.

# 3. <u>Facilitate the signature of the GBIF Protocol of agreement by the state of Cameroon</u>

Many meeting took place with the Director of coopération at the level of the ministry. They served to prepare the verbal note of the minister that will serve as an agreement principle to ratify the memorandum of understanding.

It is understood that the advocacy meeting with the minister did not take place because of his tight schedule several request for audience has been dropped and we are waiting for his answer.

#### 4. Publish some biodiversity data

- Some IUCN procedures that have been undervalued in terms of times especially with the signature of the different Subcontracts;
