Executive Summary

From March 29 to 31, a seminar "The dataset preparation in the Global Biodiversity Information Facility (GBIF)" was held in which 54 people from Lithuania, Latvia, Belarus, Ukraine took part, colleagues from Poland (Petr Tykarski), Estonia (Urmas Köljalg), Russia (Maxim Shashkov, Natalya Ivanova), the Secretariat GBIF (Dmitry Schigel) were invited as mentors and lecturers. Shows the entire algorithm for creating datasets. Participants of the seminar created test datasets prepared for publication through IPT, which is located in the NPC for Bioresources (https://www.gbif.org/installation/0ea9e953-d63c-49fb-9026-463133905424). Their quality and suitability for GBIF registration is currently being evaluated.

Based on the results of the seminar, a training manual was prepared, which is currently being adjusted and edited. Templates of informational bulletins about GBIF Poland, GBIF Belarus have been prepared. An agreement has been concluded with the publishing house for the publication of these materials. The seminar materials will be distributed to participants.

A list of organizations in Belarus, Lithuania and Lavia in which biodiversity research is carried out has been compiled. The participants of the seminar were explained the algorithm for obtaining the status of publishing organizations. During the distribution process, these organizations will be invited to obtain this status.

The list of publications on eukaryotes of Belarus, Latvia and Lithuania is being prepared. Currently, the list includes more than 19,000 publications. The list is being prepared for publication on partner sites and on the developed site gbif.by.

A list of organizations that study biological diversity and may as well potentially act as publishing organizations was complied. And analysis of the collections existing in the region is also being carried out. A seminar «The dataset preparation in the Global Biodiversity Information Facility (GBIF)» was held (March 29-31). The seminar was attended by 54 people from various organizations of Belarus, Latvia, Lithuania, Poland, Russia, Ukraine and Estonia. The seminar was held online using Zoom. The operation of IPT is maintained (https://www.gbif.org/installation/0ea9e953-d63c-49fb-9026-463133905424). This recourse is used to host datasets including ones developed during the seminar. 17 datasets have been prepared by now (14 of them were prepared during the seminar). The translation of gbif.org into Russian has been started taking into account the work that has already been done while developing gbif.ru. The compiling of list of publications on the eukaryotes of Belarus, Latvia and Lithuania is in progress. Currently the list includes more than 15 000 items and is being prepared to be published on the Internet resources of the project partners. The compiling of list of eukaryotes indicated in publications for Belarus, Latvia and Lithuania is in progress. The interface of gbif.by website is being developed and materials for publication are being prepared. The work is going on as planned, there are some difficulties in preparing a list of publications on the eukaryotes of Lithuania and Latvia, since this work requires the search for additional funding. Work is also being done in this direction. An additional workshop on the preparation of datasets and the adjustment of training materials will be held during the conference
