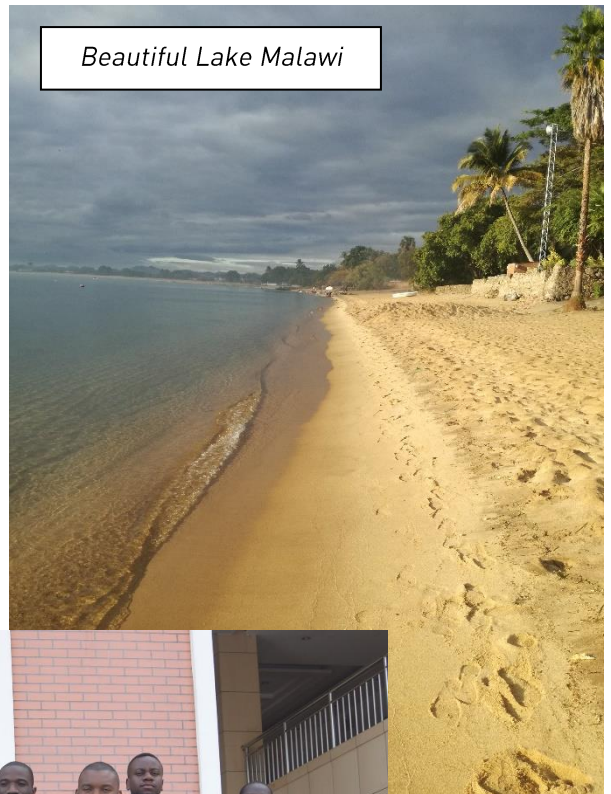
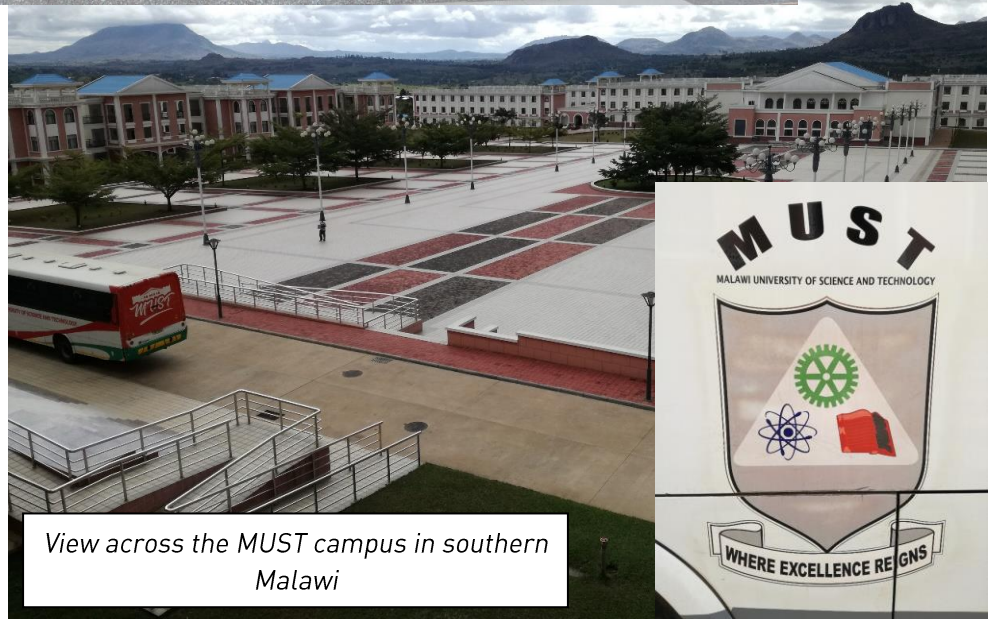


Dr. Lizanne Roxburgh, the EWT's Senior Scientist and GBIF Node Manager, travelled to southern Malawi in late June, to give a 2-day course to post-graduate students and staff from various universities and institutions across the country. She was hosted by Dr. Tiwonge Mzumara at the Malawi University of Science and Technology. The course covered aspects of management, cleaning, standardisation and sharing of biodiversity datasets and an introduction to GBIF. Malawi recently participated in the African Biodiversity Challenge, and has published over 20 000 new open access records about Malawian biodiversity to GBIF. The aim of our training was to spread these skills to other researchers and institutions in the country, to further build and share datasets about Malawi's biodiversity.
