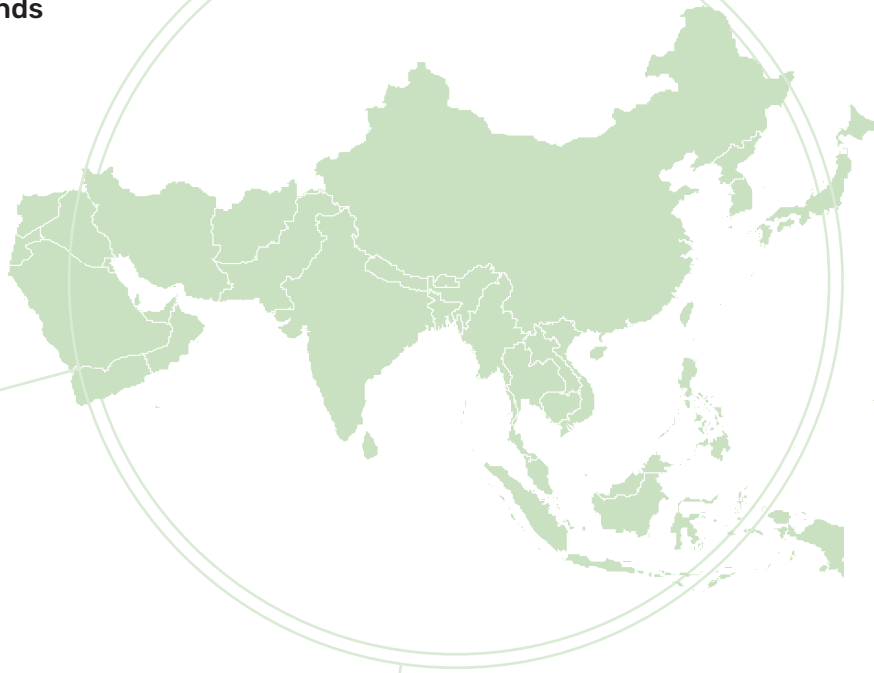

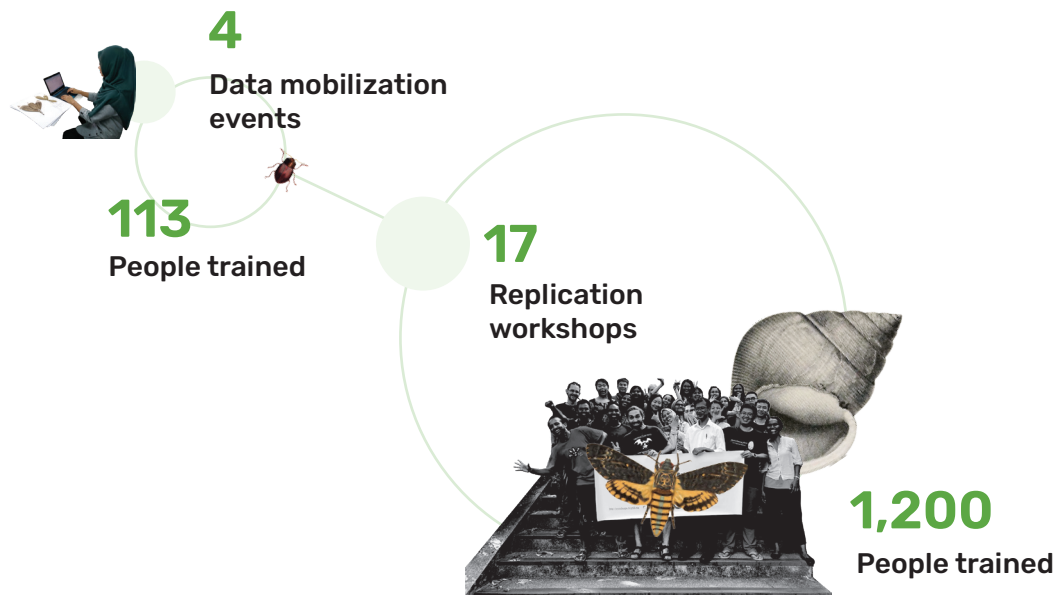

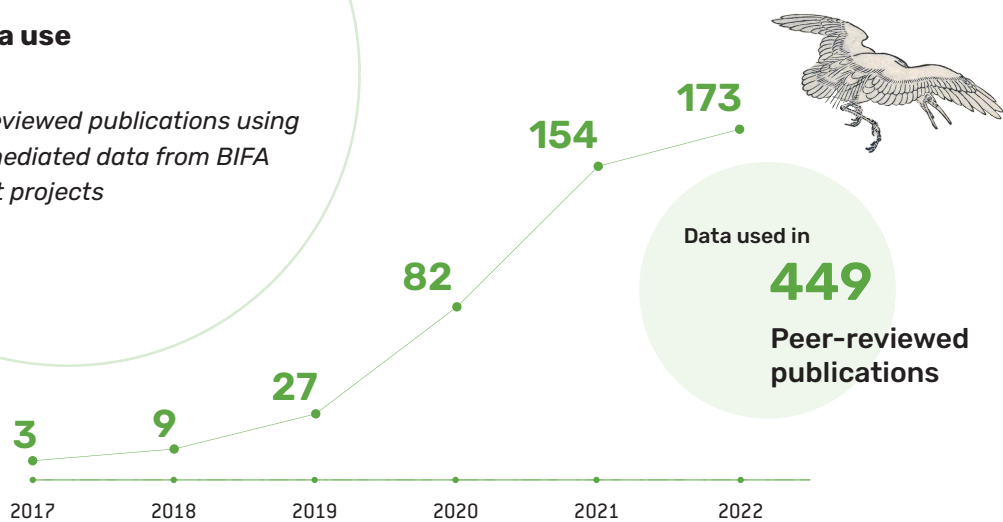

Grants from the BIFA programme have funded 46 projects across Asia, supporting data mobilization and capacity development activities while contributing to a growing regional community of practice

Projects funded through BIFA have filled taxonomic and geographic data gaps by mobilizing almost half a million records, including data derived from DNA barcodes and information on the distribution of the hosts, reservoirs and vectors of human disease
