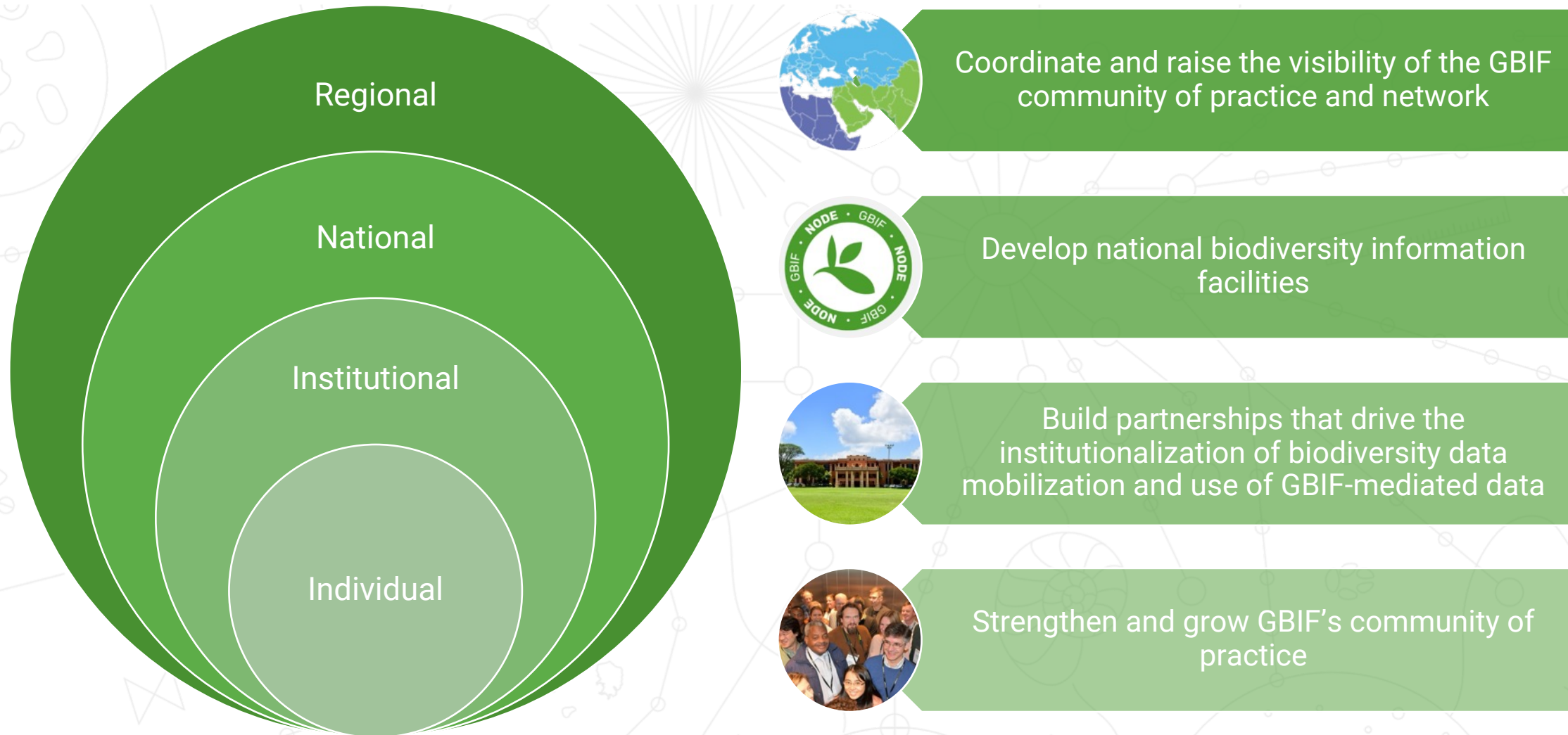

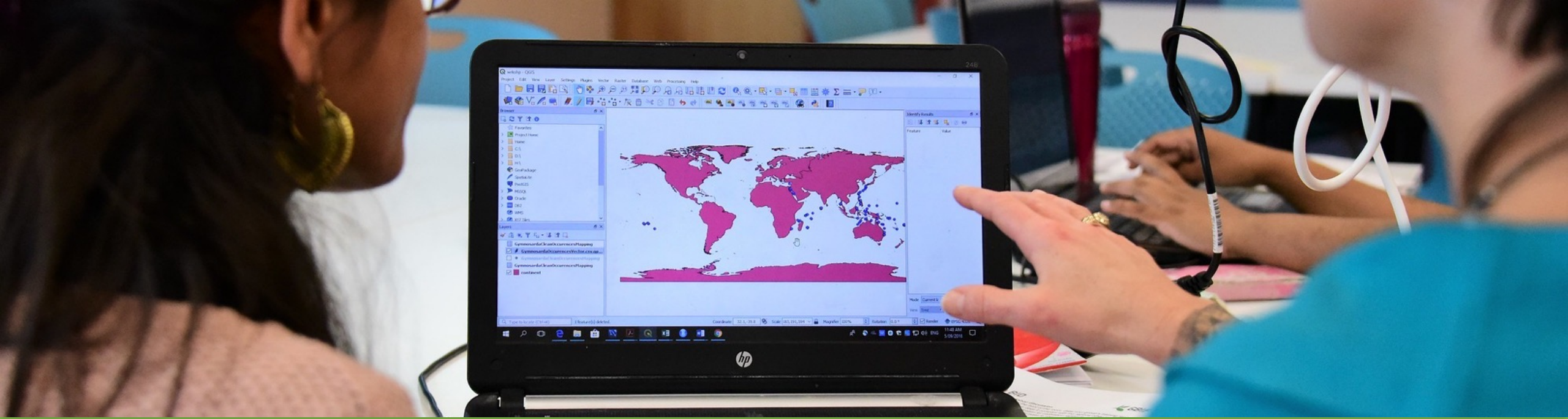

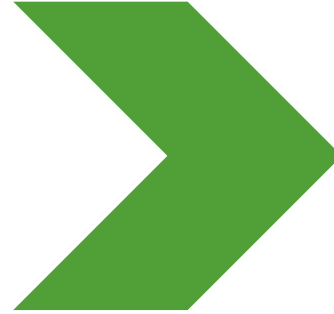
MULTIPLIER EFFECT



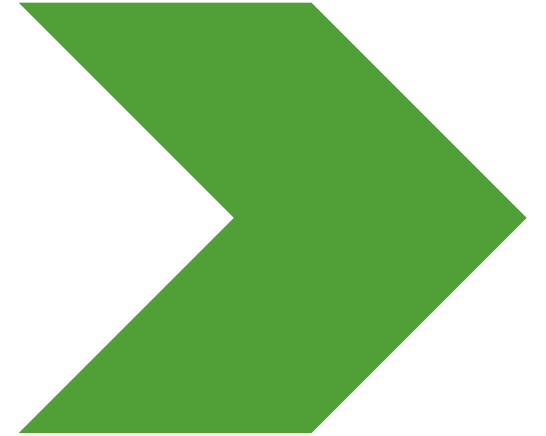
15 GBIFs- led training events on **Data Mobilization** and **Data Use** organized through BID and BIFA programmes since 2015

... and reuse of the training materials is still ongoing!

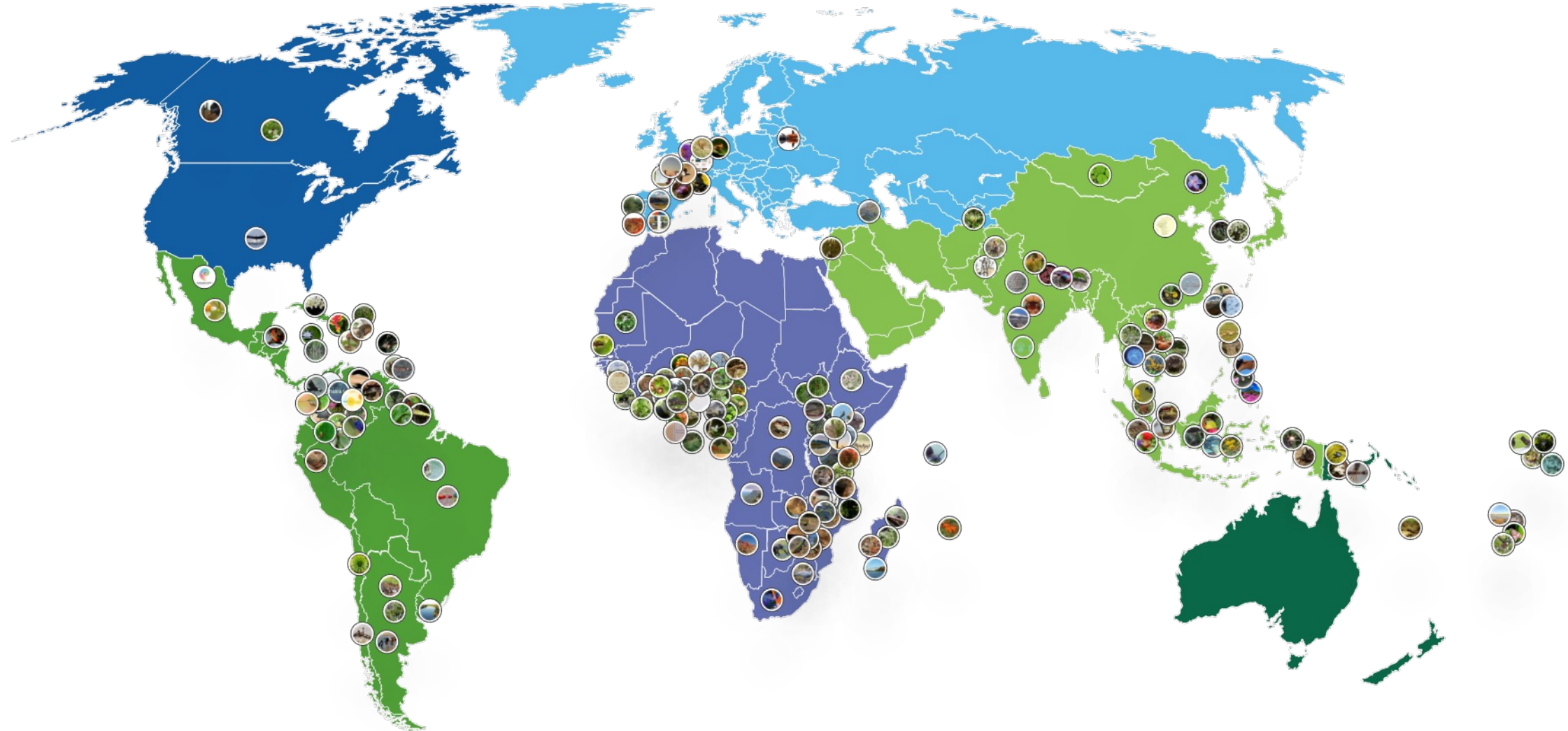

PROJECTS FUNDED THROUGH GBIF PROGRAMMES IN THE LAST 6 YEARS

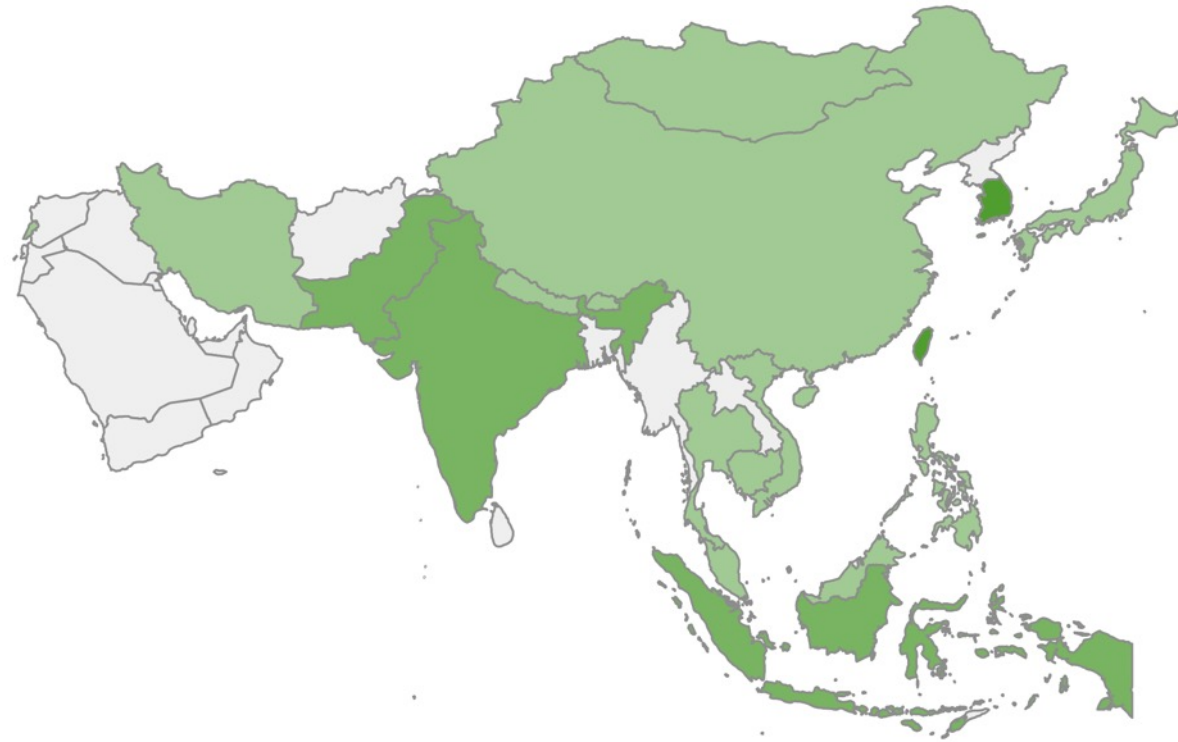

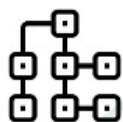
