3.1. Executive summary

This reporting period started with the uploading of TroPEG 23, 327 initial records to GBIF portal. This was followed by the announcement of four day training on Biodiversity data capture, cleaning and management. The called for application was made via TroPEG website (http://tropegcam.org/2018/01/25/training-on-data-mobilization-and-biodiversity-informatics/). In all, 32 students applied from different disciplines and Universities in Cameroon. To achieve our goal on capacity building and due to the interest in this course, the number of participants was raise from 15 to 23. The workshop was organized by TroPEG Cameroon and Biodiversity Institute, University of Kansas in collaboration with the Department of Botany and Plant Physiology, University of Buea.
