# NODES COMMITTEE REPORT - RECOMMENDATIONS

- **Capacity building** is a fundamental instrument that serves existing participant nodes and offer opportunity for non participants to discover our community. Such programmes should be continued and possibly upscaled with external fundings
- **Data Standards and tools** have to evolve, GBIF community, with TDWG and Alliance partners are in the best position to steer this process in the most efficient way
- Find appropriate ways to engage countries of the **emerging markets**.
- Strengthen the link with **scientific/academic community**
- **Data citation mechanisms** should be improved to support citation tracking down to the individual collector or observer
