NODES COMMITTEE REPORT - RECOMMENDATIONS

- Capacity building is a fundamental instrument that serves existing participant nodes and offer opportunity for non participants to discover our community. Such programmes should be continued and possibly upscaled with external fundings
- Data Standards and tools have to evolve, GBIF community, with TDWG and Alliance partners are in the best position to steer this process in the most efficient way
- Find appropriate ways to engage countries of the emerging markets.
- Strengthen the link with scientific/academic community
- Data citation mechanisms should be improved to support citation tracking down to the individual collector or observer
