## 3. Overview of results

### 3.1. Executive summary

Give a short summary of the activities implemented and the outcomes of the project for the reporting period (500 words maximum).

Agricultural production continues to be hampered by both native and invasive insect and mite pests. Adequate biological information is essential for their timely identification and management. The aim of this project is to mobilize biodiversity information embedded on specimens in three agricultural insect collections in Cameroon. IRAD and IITA insect collections have been visited several times. IRAD collection was found containing a considerable number of insect specimens including non pest species belonging to the orders Lepidoptera (moths), Coleaoptera (Carabids), Manthodea but also important pest specimens belonging to the orders Hemiptera. Orthoptera. Coleoptera (Chrysomilids) etc. If a scientific name was attached to most of these specimens, the spelling and the validity of these names has to be checked closely. IITA collection contains also pests and non pest specimens. Contrasting with IRAD one, most specimens in IITA collection are not identified. Emphasis should then be put on the identification of this material without which the dataset cannot be published. There is no active curator working on these collections. Non pest specimens both from IRAD and IITA collection have been excluded, then about 1500 and 500 specimens respectively were sorted, uniquely identified by adding labels and are ready for digitization. In addition about 200 specimens from the Faculty of Science of the University of Douala are also ready for digitization. Two workshops on good practices in data mobilization through the GBIF portal have been organised in Douala (45 participants) on 23 November 2017 then in Yaoundé (15 participants) on the 1<sup>st</sup> December 2017 followed with bench training. The content of the workshop focused on general presentation of the GBIF network, the search, collection and uses of data from the GBIF portal, good practices for data organisation, georeferencing, data quality and the publication process. Training scheme consisted both of oral and practical sessions. Trained student in Douala and technicians in Yaoundé have started capturing information







on labels attached to each sorted specimen in the GBIF template. One person from the project attended the Capacity Enhancement workshop on Data Mobilization and is now sharing learned skills with project members through bench training. A workshop involving 10 participants is tentatively scheduled for 23 February 2018. The candidate for the second training has already been selected.
