III. Key data sets

23. The regional assessments will draw on a wide variety of data sets addressing all the specific components of the conceptual framework. A key activity of the regional and subregional assessments will be to identify relevant data sets, including those arising from ongoing and planned activities, from a wide range of sources, including global, regional and national institutions and organizations, as well as research projects and analysis of the scientific literature and indigenous and local knowledge.
