Put your personal belongings on the shelf while you're not washing off.

Don't wash yourself off in the bath. You also shouldn't swim in the bath, or drink alcohol during a bath. To help keep the bathwater clean, make sure your towel stays out of the water. If you have long hair, tie it into a bun to keep it out of the water, too.
