

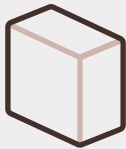

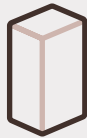
Hogwarts Castle Build

Part 1: The Great Hall

To make the Great Hall, you will need:



1 large cardboard box measuring about 30x20x20cm



1 small cardboard box measuring about 22x6x10cm



Lots of pieces of cardboard



Strong tape



Scissors



A marker pen



A pencil



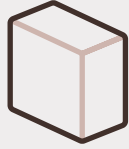

These instructions feature the use of sharp tools so adults should always supervise children



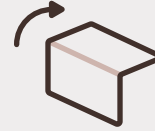
Step by Step Instructions - Page 1

1.



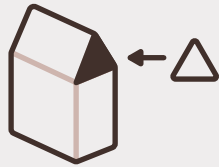
Take a big cardboard box measuring about **30x20x20cm**. This will be your Great Hall. Tape it closed to keep it strong.

2.



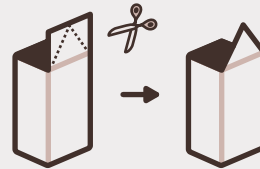
Take a piece of cardboard around **25cm** long and **30cm** wide and fold it in half to create the roof. Tape it to the top of your box.

3.



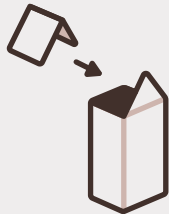
Measure the size of the triangle gaps of your roof and cut it out of cardboard. Tape it in place to create a solid shape.

4.



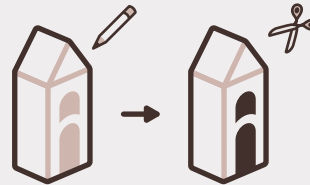
Take a smaller box measuring about **22x6x10cm** to create the Entrance Hall. Cut a triangle down from the top of about 6cm down to create the shape of the roof.

5.



Take two pieces of card of about **6x9cm**, tape together, and attach to create the roof.

6.



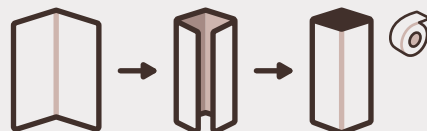
Draw on the shape of the door to the Great Hall and a large opening above it and then cut them out with scissors. Attach the Entrance Hall to the end of the Great Hall.

7.



To make the turret in the middle of the hall, take a small piece of cardboard of about **8cmx10cm** and bend it in half. Sorting Ceremony this way!

8.



Then bend each half in half again to make a rectangular tube. Tape it in place.

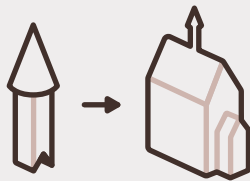
Cut two small triangles in the bottom at opposite sides of the tube, so it can sit on top of the roof of the hall.

10.



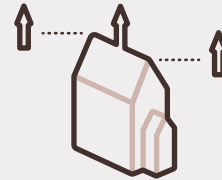
Take a piece of flexible card and roll it into a cone. Tape it in place and cut off the excess.

11.



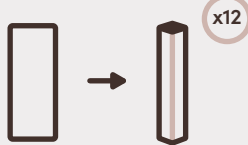
Put it on top of the tube and attach the turret to the middle of the roof.

12.



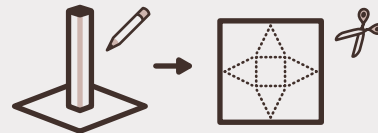
Do the same for the two turrets at either end of the roof, but only cut **one** triangle in the bottom to attach to the ends of the roof.

13.



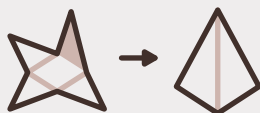
To make the turrets around the outside you need 12 pieces of card of about **26x6cm**. Fold them into rectangular tubes and tape in place.

14.



To make the triangle-shaped roofs, draw around the square end of the tube on to a thin piece of card. Draw a small triangle from each side of the square and cut the shape out.

15.



Fold the triangles up toward the middle and tape in place. Attach the roofs to the top of each of your 12 turrets. Post owls would love to perch on these!

16.



Tape a turret to each side of the Entrance Hall and attach five along each side of The Great Hall.
