## **Blood Glucose Testing: Fact Sheet**

- Blood Glucose tests for most children with diabetes are required before breakfast, before lunch, before dinner and before bed.
- Sometimes additional overnight blood glucose tests are required on days where children have been more active than usual or whenever there is concern about overnight levels.
- Hands must be washed and dried thoroughly before blood glucose tests are taken.
- Hands and fingers must be warm when blood glucose tests are taken.
- Keeping the finger under the level of the heart will help with blood flow and make it easier to undertake the blood glucose test.
- It is important to use the sides of the fingertips for blood glucose tests to avoid damage to the nerves.
- Blood glucose test results must be documented within a diabetes log book or uploaded into an approved computer programme.
- Finger-prick lancets must be changed frequently and disposed of in an approved sharps container.
