Cancer cells are shape shifters. They bend and twist to adapt to their surroundings, using this special ability to squeeze themselves into new locations, and to spread and grow elsewhere in the body. And if a cancer does manage to spread, it's usually much harder to treat.

One of our top scientists has been spying on cancer cells' behaviour and has pinpointed 14 genes that are behind this morphing power. Armed with this information, he's now working on ways to block or interfere with these genes – like a molecular freeze ray to trap the cancer cells in one shape.

 Robbing cancer cells of their shape-shifting ability could help stop them from spreading around the body - boosting people's chance of beating their cancer.
