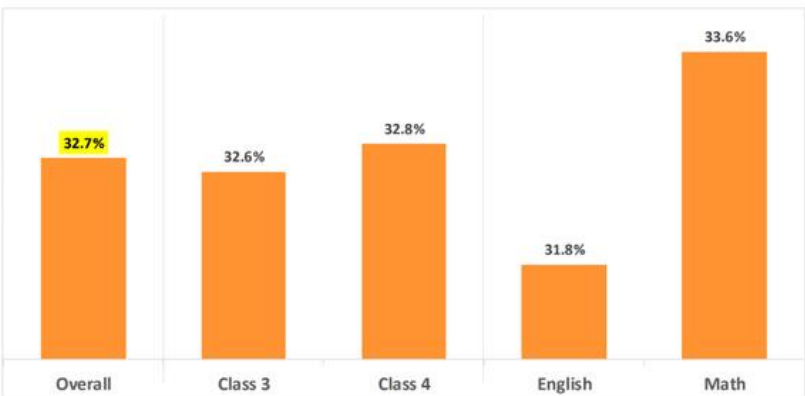

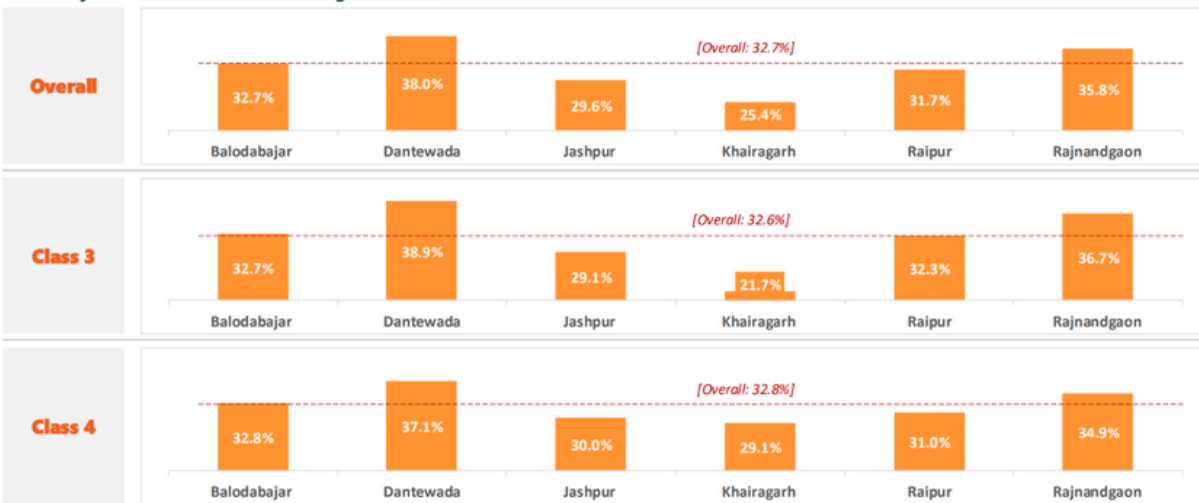

Dantewada exhibited the highest proficiency, with 38.0% of students demonstrating grade-level skills, while Khairagarh had the lowest, with only 25.4% of students achieving the same

## Glimpses From the Field – Meetings with Government Officials

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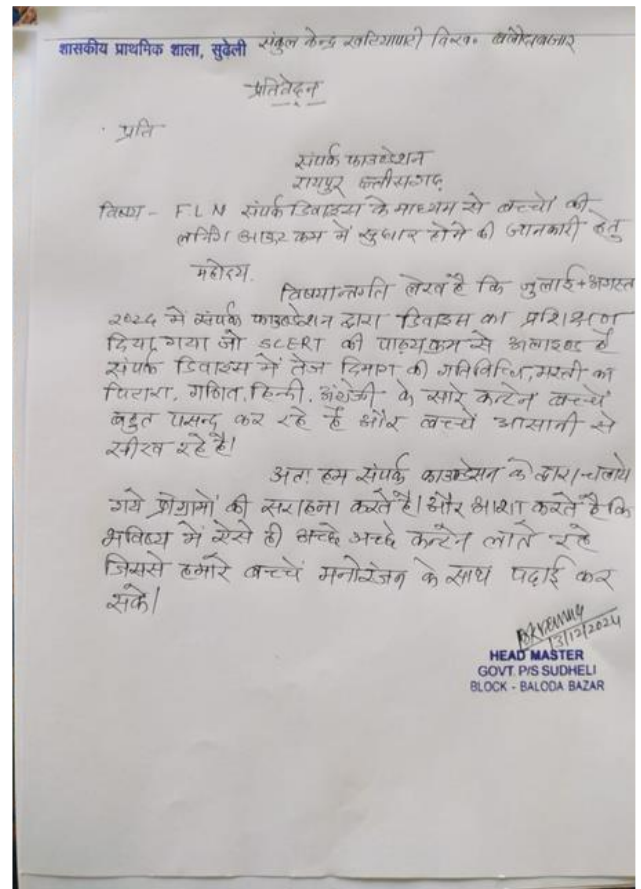
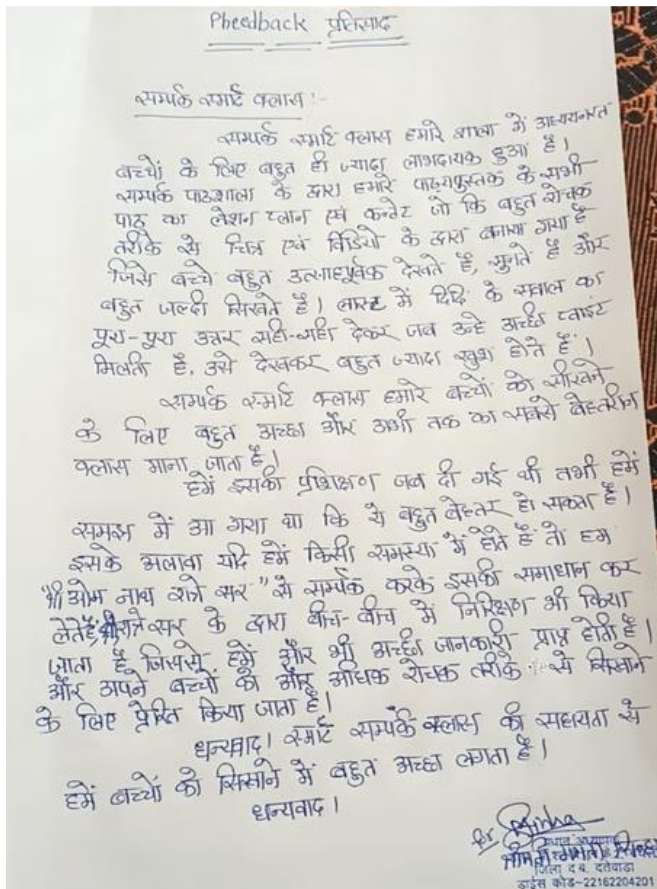
