We support transparency and honesty so that we can work with others to protect the rights of workers, particularly those who are most vulnerable or at greatest risk of abuses.

Due Diligence

Puttshack aims to buy from suppliers which share and can demonstrate an awareness of and comply with the appropriate social and ethical standards we promote. Following the introduction of the Act, all our suppliers have been asked to sign and return an amendment to their terms and conditions positively confirming that slavery and human trafficking are not taking place within their business and throughout their supply chain.

This statement has been published in accordance with the Modern Slavery Act (2015). It sets out the steps taken by Puttshack to prevent modern slavery occurring in our business and across our supply chain.
