Sydney Airport CEO Geoff Culbert said, “More than 3.6 million passengers travelled through Sydney Airport in March.

“International and Domestic passenger numbers declined 3.8% and 3.4% respectively on the prior corresponding period. As expected, International passenger numbers were impacted by a shift in timing of both Easter and Lunar New Year driving decreases in both seat capacity and load factors. However, strong load factors on North American routes helped boost US traveller growth to 11%.

“Domestically, the trends for March were similar to the year to date, where a decrease in frequencies, aircraft downgauging and subdued load factors drove a reduction in domestic passengers for the month.”

Highlight

- Qantas Sydney – Nadi route commenced 31 March with a 174 seat 737-800 aircraft operating four times a week.
