From 19 November 2023 you will be able to travel East on Sydney Gateway's new Twin Arch Bridge over Alexandra Canal in Tempe.

This is the first of two Twin Arch Bridges, with the second bridge ready for vehicles early next year. As we make changes to how you move around the Airport Precinct, please travel with care, follow directional signs, maintain the required speed limit and plan your trip before travelling.





# What will change when the Twin Arch Bridge opens?



Vehicles going east,
near the International
Terminal, will be directed
onto the new Twin Arch
Bridge and the existing
eastbound movement on
Airport Drive will be removed.
Westbound traffic movements
will remain the same.



Freight travelling east to the Sydney Airport freight international terminal will go over the Twin Arch Bridge and use the new Link Road connection. Westbound traffic movements will remain the same.
