The number of passengers who travelled through Sydney Airport last month grew by 2.4 percent compared to May 2018. International passengers grew by 6.3 percent to 1.3 million passengers and Domestic passengers grew by 0.3 percent to 2.2 million passengers.

Sydney Airport CEO Geoff Culbert said, "The strong International passenger growth in May was driven by increased demand and subsequent load factor increases across most destinations.

"We continue to have a diverse nationality mix coming through Sydney Airport. In May, we saw double-digit growth from Malaysia, the USA, Greater China and Japan."

Highlights

- Malindo Air will commence a daily service from Kuala Lumpur via Denpasar in mid-August, operating a 162 seat B737-800
- Qantas' seasonal Sapporo service will commence in mid-December with a 251 seat A330-200 aircraft operating three times per week through to late-March
