


### FLOATING MARKETS

The Damnoen Saduak floating market is one of the most popular markets of its kind. Opened to the public in 1868, the market is packed with vendors and customers floating in their rowing boats, selling and buying produce. Observe traditional Thai culture and sample local produce through a guided tour of the markets.



### PRATANAM RESTAURANTS

Pratanam is an area of Bangkok known for its good value hotels, markets and produce. In this area you can sample food from all around the globe. To sample excellent Thai food suitable for the Western palate the Once Upon a Time restaurant is favoured by tourists. The Tae Chew restaurant inside the Grand Diamond Suites Hotel is a Chinese food haven, known for its dim sum, roast duck and hot and sour soup. Platinum Mall shopping centre also hosts a diverse range of food outlets.



### TEMPLE OF DAWN

Sitting on the Chao Phraya River, the Temple of Dawn is one of many Bangkok temples scattered across the city. The Temple of Dawn is named after the Indian God of Dawn, 'Aruna' and was constructed in the 17th century. Tourists can climb up the temple to view the river and surrounds. The east side of the river is regarded as the best view of the temple at sunset, when the temple's silhouette is displayed across the skyline.



## THE GRAND PALACE & WAT PRAKEAW

The Grand Palace is one of the most famous sites in Bangkok and was home to the Thai King for 150 years. Today, the site is a beautiful, dazzling tribute to the Thai Kingdom. Several different buildings make up the Grand Palace complex and the Reception Halls are still frequently used for ceremonies and rituals. The detail and unique architecture of the buildings are impressive and astounding, transporting you right inside the Royal Family style of living.

- Check the security regulations in relation to what you can and cannot take through the security screening point and onto an aircraft, including prohibited items, dangerous goods, and liquids, aerosols, and gels (LAGs).
- Check your baggage allowance with your airline.
- Use the directional signage at the terminal to ensure a smooth and enjoyable journey through the airport.
- Ensure that your driver's licence can be used in your country of destination or that you have organised an international driver's licence.
- If you have not already purchased travel insurance along with your ticket, you can purchase it at Sydney Airport at the Last Chance Travel Insurance located in the International Terminal (T1) after Customs.
   Alternatively, purchase insurance at any Travelex outlet or the Australia Post Shop at International Terminal (T1) located before Customs, near check-in counter J.

#### **GET TO THE AIRPORT**

 Make sure you have plenty of time ahead of check-in. If you are unsure as to when you should arrive at the airport, contact your airline directly.

#### GET READY FOR BOARDING

- Security screening whether your destination is within Australia or overseas, allow sufficient time to proceed through security screening.
- Australian Customs and Border Protection Service – allow sufficient time to proceed through Customs and Border Protection.
- Passports must be valid for a minimum of six months ahead of your departing date for most countries. We strongly recommend you verify exact requirements with your airline.
- Boarding passes issued at the airline check-in counter upon presentation of your ticket reservation (printed e-ticket) or booking confirmation number along with your valid passport.
- Immigration cards available before you enter Customs and Border Protection. The cards must be filled out and presented to the Customs and Border Protection Officer along with your passport and boarding pass.
- Find your departing gate using display screens. These screens are available in the airline check-in area and at each departure gate.
