- Complete corresponding Airside Driver Awareness eLearning.
- Category 2 minimum 20 hours driving airside; 15 hours during daylight, 5 hours during darkness.
- Category 2S Minimum 20 hours driving airside 15 hours in daylight, 5 hours in darkness with an additional 3 hours of daylight and 2 hours of night driving in areas south of the Kilo Standoff Apron, and the Number 2 Fire Station.
- Category 2PI/D minimum 20 hours driving airside; 15 hours during day light, 5 hours during darkness.
- Category 3 minimum 30 hours driving on the manoeuvring area airside; 25 hours during daylight, 5 hours during darkness.
- Category 4 minimum 40 hours driving on the manoeuvring area airside; 35 hours during daylight, 5 hours during darkness.

## Additional notes:

- Maximum of 1 hour driving time recorded per day.
- Category 2PI/D & 4 applicants must submit a Practical Observation Log (POL).
- Company Trainer must sign verifying completed hours.
