Total passenger traffic in October 2021 was 65,000 passengers, down 98.4% on the corresponding period in 2019.

Domestic passenger traffic totalled 46,000 in October 2021, down 98.2% on the corresponding period in 2019.

19,000 international passengers passed through Sydney Airport in October 2021, down 98.6% on the corresponding period in 2019. International passenger traffic in October continued to be impacted by border restrictions.

From 1 November 2021, international borders were open to Australian citizens and permanent residents who were fully vaccinated. From 5 November 2021 the Victorian and New South Wales borders were opened, allowing free travel between these states.

For the first 15 days of November, provisional data indicates international passenger traffic was down approximately 95% and domestic passenger traffic was down approximately 87% on the corresponding period in 2019.

As per previous information releases, these figures may contain estimates with any adjustments to preliminary statistics included in the year-to-date results in future months
