

This is also the time when couples of horses are boarded. These horses will not be stabled for the next few months and are therefore dependent on what the pastures have to offer. Not all pastures are rich in vitamins and minerals and during the grazing season, nutrients often decrease. To prevent deficiencies, we advise to place a Mineral Block in the pasture. The EquiFirst Mineral Block contains several vitamins and minerals and is on average sufficient for 8 horses during 1 month. Horses will use the Mineral Block themselves according to their needs, so that they still get all the daily nutrients they need.
