Ponies: 1/3 to 1/2 of the above amount

Mares in foal: 150 grams (during the last 3 months of pregnancy, up to 3 months after birth)

Foals (2 months – 1 yr.): 50 grams, building up to 100 grams

Breeding stallions: 200 grams (during mating season)

Ideally given with concentrated feed.
