



Rabbits and rodents

Feed for rabbits and rodents should meet the natural needs as much as possible. In nature, the diet of rabbits mainly consists of grasses, herbs and the bark of young twigs. The diet of rodents often consists of seeds and/or other vegetable products, with some rodents also eating certain insects to meet their animal protein needs.

The amount of feed rabbits and rodents eat depends on breed, size, age and season. For example, if rabbits are kept outside, their nutritional needs will be higher during the winter months, compared to the summer, in order to keep themselves warm. This brochure contains more information about feeding rabbits and rodents. Kasper Faunafood has a wide range of feeds for rabbits and rodents.









Rabbits

Kasper Faunafood rabbit feeds consist of a series of pure plant-based pressed pellets, mixed feeds and a muesli. These feeds have been developed to meet the dietary requirements of rabbits, and they are easily digestible and ensure normal digestion. An important ingredient is alfalfa. It contains a lot of fibre, good proteins, and is low in starch and sugars. Rabbits are the ultimate herbivore animals and they have a long digestive system. Rabbits need raw fibre in the form of hay. The ideal ration for rabbits is therefore to combine Kasper Faunafood rabbit feeds with hay.

Rabbits are kept for different reasons, and each has different nutritional requirements. The Rabbit Pellet Hobby is suitable for rabbits kept as pets. The different types of Mixed Rabbit Feed or Rabbit Muesli can also be used with good results. Rabbit Pellet Sport and Rabbit Pellet Fit are intended for and highly suitable for rabbits that are kept for raising young, are judged at exhibitions or live in a group. These feeds contain more protein and energy, which is especially

important for females. Furthermore, they also contain additional ingredients that support their digestion and intestinal health. To provide extra support to a nursing rabbit in her final days of pregnancy and during the suckling period, Cuni 100 Rearing Pellet is highly advised. After a few days, young rabbits can start eating the same foodstuff as their mother does. After weaning, they often continue to eat the same foodstuff. Young rabbits can also be fed Rabbit Pellet Junior.





Pressed feeders

The pressed rabbit pellets contain all the nutrients in the right proportion rabbits need. Every pellet has the same nutritional content, which removes concerns about selective eating behaviours. In addition to these feeds, you must always make sure there is plenty of hay available.

Herbal extract

Herbal extracts as oregano (with carvacrol and thymol) are used to naturally support the health of the gastrointestinal tract, which is especially relevant for rabbits that do not (vet) have sufficient natural resistance.



Mixed feeders

In addition to the pressed pellets, Kasper Faunafood also has mixed feeds for rabbits. These feeds consist of separate ingredients, such as whole and digested grains, seeds, vegetables and a vitamin-mineral pellet. These tasty and varied feeds meet the nutritional needs of rabbits if everything is eaten and plenty of hay is available. Mixed feeds can also be used as variation and fed in combination with a pressed pellet.

Feeding advice

The feed intake depends on breed and age, but especially on the size (weight) of the rabbit. The nutrition requirements are higher during winter period because of the cold outside temperatures. Limiting feed intake is possible to prevent fattening.

Young rabbits can be fed without restriction. Clean the bowl regularly and refresh the feed daily. In addition, always provide plenty of fresh drinking water. Rabbits in a spacious outdoor enclosure with a lot of grass at their disposal can be given less per day. The feeding schedule can be used as a guideline.

Pregnant and nursing does should have access to hay, pellets and water all day long. Switch slowly from one product to another.



Rodents

Feed for rodents should meet the natural needs as much as possible. Most rodents are herbivores, but some are omnivores or carnivores. Kasper Faunafood has various feeds for rodents whose natural diet consists mainly of plants, grains and seeds.

Most rodents are small, robust animals with short limbs and a long tail. They can all be identified by their well-developed incisors. They use their sharp teeth to gnaw, dig burrows and defend themselves. The incisors grow continuously, even when the animal is adult. Wear of teeth has to be in the same rate as they grow and therefore rodents have to gnaw.

Kasper Faunafood has products suited for different types of rodents.



Rats

Rats are omnivores, rats need small amounts of animal protein every now and then. This can be offered in the form of (dried) insects, egg, or a piece of chicken or beef. As variation, various vegetables and fruits, such as apple, pear, banana, endive, carrot and kale can be provided. Rats eat an average of 15-25 grammes per day.



Gerbils

Gerbils naturally eat plant-based food such as seeds, grains, and other plant parts, as well as small animals like insects. Gerbils are used to a meagre diet. This means about 10-15 grammes every day. Their digestive system is adapted to such small amounts of food and water.

As a variation, small amounts of animal protein and small pieces of fruits and vegetables, such as apple and broccoli, can be provided. Always provide sufficient hay, fibre is very important for good digestion in gerbils.

Mice

There are different species of mice; the vole is a herbivore, the house mouse is an omnivore, and the northern grasshopper mouse is a carnivore. Their food is both plant and animal-based. As a supplement, provide fresh vegetables or fruit occasionally with some animal protein, such as a piece of boiled egg, an insect or a piece of cooked chicken.

Mice eat an average of 10 grammes per animal per day. Hay should always be available in sufficient quantity. Fibre is very important for the mouse's digestion.

Hamsters

Hamsters are omnivores, they can live well on a plant-based diet, but they do like to eat animal proteins. Therefore, offer them a product with animal protein 1 to 2 times a week. For a healthy intestine it is good to offer sufficient hay.

Average intake depends on the type of hamster. A Syrian hamster eats about 10-20 grammes per day, while a dwarf hamster eats 5-10 grammes per day. A hamster stores supplies in its nest and in its cheek bags (hoarding). So, even if the bowl is empty, it doesn't mean the hamster has eaten everything.

Squirrels

Squirrels often hoard their food. If the bowl is empty, it doesn't mean the animal has eaten everything, it has probably dragged everything into its burrow. Therefore, only feed the animal small amounts and as little as possible, especially if it is perishable. The diet should be varied but not too fatty. Squirrels not only eat foodstuff composed of vegetables, they also need some animal protein. A squirrel eats 5% of its body weight per day.

Chinchillas

Chinchillas are herbivores and have a sensitive and long digestive system that is geared to a fibre-rich, but rather meagre diet. It is attuned to the sober offerings available to the chinchilla in its original habitat. Do not give chinchillas too much; 20-30 grammes per day is sufficient.

Chinchillas need plenty of roughage. It is important to offer the chinchilla plenty of good-quality hay. Offer the very occasional green leaf (endive) or some blades of grass.

Degus

Degus live in the wild on rocky terrain with shrubby vegetation. They eat grains, grasses, seeds and everything else that is available and edible. Degus like to eat small amounts of fruits and vegetables, but don't give them too much as this can cause intestinal problems. Give degus a measured amount to eat; they easily get fat because they are adapted to the scarce diet in the mountains. Do not offer more than 1 to 2 teaspoons per day. Hay is a very suitable because it is high in fibre. Make sure this is always available in sufficient quantities in the accommodation.

Guinea pigs

There are two important nutrients definitely required to keep a guinea pig healthy. First, guinea pigs have a significant need for raw fibre. The best fibre supplier for the guinea pig is hay, which should always be available in sufficient quantities. Hay is important to stimulate the intestinal function and to wear down teeth. The second important nutrient for a guinea pig is vitamin C. A guinea pig cannot make this vitamin itself. Guinea pigs can be fed according to their needs; they will stop eating when they have have meet their requirements. Suitable fruit and vegetables for guinea pigs are apple, chicory, carrot, kale and endive.
