About Bootcamp Courses

Bootcamps provide job-ready training across IT disciplines such as Cyber Security, Cloud, AI, Data, and Full Stack Development. Each bootcamp has a defined maximum duration with the option to complete earlier if you progress faster.

1. Enrolment and Identification Requirements

- Students must complete the online enrolment form and accept the Student Enrolment Agreement.
- One form of government-issued photo ID (e.g. passport, driver's licence) plus one supporting document (e.g. Medicare card, utility bill) is required.
- Students under 18 must have a parent/guardian complete a consent form.

2. Entry Requirements

- Minimum age 17 (exceptions may apply).
- Sufficient foundation skills (reading, writing, numeracy, digital).
- Access to required technology (see Section 5).
- Ability to meet payment obligations.

3. Orientation

- After enrolment, you can attend an online Meet and Greet session to connect with your trainer and learn about the course.
- This is an opportunity to connect with your trainer, explore StudySpot (our LMS), and learn about the support available.
- The session introduces your trainer, explains how to navigate StudySpot (our LMS), and outlines support options.

4. Course Delivery

- Delivered 100% online.
- Includes self-paced modules, online resources, webinars, Q&A sessions, and one-on-one trainer support.
- Students are encouraged to stay in regular contact with their trainer to support learning and progression.
- The bootcamps include vendor exam vouchers (see Section 10).

5. Technology Access

General technology requirements for most courses:

- Windows 10/11 or macOS Big Sur (or later)
- Minimum 16GB RAM
- Modern browser (Edge, Chrome, Firefox or Safari)
- Webcam, headset and reliable internet connection
- Access provided to StudySpot LMS for resources, assessments and communication

Students enrolled in Certified Unity Game Developer are also required to have access to:

- Dedicated GPU (e.g. NVIDIA GTX 1650 / RTX 2060 or AMD RX 6500, or equivalent)
- SSD storage recommended
- Display resolution of 1920 x 1080 or better

These additional requirements are due to the practical and real-time rendering requirements of the course software.

Mac devices using Apple Silicon (M1/M2/M3/M4) also meet the graphics requirements for the course.

Students are responsible for ensuring their personal device meets the technology requirements for their enrolled course. Lumify Learn accepts no responsibility for personal electronic devices utilised during the course and undertakes no responsibility to investigate device damage, faults or performance issues.

6. Fees and Payment

- \$790 enrolment fee applies to all courses (non-refundable).
- Payment can be upfront, where an applicable discount will apply or via payment plan instalments, with transaction/admin fees.
- Certificates are issued only once fees are paid in full.

7. Course Duration and Extensions

- Course duration differs between programs and is outlined on the Lumify Learn website and in the course brochures.
- Extensions may be available upon application. If approved, an additional fee may apply.

8. Cooling-Off Period

- You may withdraw within 10 working days of course commencement.
- In this case, only the \$790 enrolment fee applies.

9. Withdrawals

- If you withdraw after the cooling-off period, you remain liable for 100% of course fees (including any outstanding instalments).
- Please refer to the Withdrawal and Refund Policy for complete details.

10. Learning Resources and Certification

- You are required to complete all learning activities and any vendor exam requirements within the course duration.
- Certification exams are run by the vendor (e.g., Microsoft, AWS, CompTIA) under their own rules. Lumify Learn provides one exam voucher per module. Replacement vouchers (for no-shows or exam failures) must be purchased by the student at their own cost.
- To be eligible for certification, you must:
 - Complete all learning activities and assessments
 - Successfully pass the vendor exams
 - Finalise all course fee payments.

11. Student Responsibilities and Rights

Responsibilities:

- Actively engage in learning and maintain trainer contact.
- Complete all activities within the timeframe.
- Pay all fees on schedule.
- Maintain respectful conduct (see Section 17).

12. Trainer Support and Communication

13. Certificates and Vendor Badges

- Upon successful completion of your Bootcamp (all Lumify Learn course requirements and fees paid), you will receive a Lumify Learn Certificate of Completion.
- Vendor-issued certifications and digital badges (e.g., Microsoft, AWS, CompTIA) are awarded only when you successfully pass the relevant vendor exams, in line with the rules of the certification body.

14. Complaints and Appeals

- Lumify Learn ensures complaints are acknowledged and investigated fairly and in a timely manner.

15. Record Keeping and Privacy

- Breaches may result in suspension or cancellation of enrolment.

17. Breach of Policies: Non-Academic Misconduct and Discipline

Lumify Learn reserves the right to review the enrolment status of any student whose conduct or performance is not of an acceptable standard or if there is a breach of any policy stated within this handbook. Penalties for breaches of rules, or unsuitable or disruptive behaviour will be imposed depending on the nature and severity of the breach. A warning will be given for minor breaches and students will be suspended from training for more serious breaches.
