Located in Fannin
County, the lake
will benefit the local
and regional economy

A good site, with limited wetlands, a naturally deep channel, and no gas and oil wells

UTRWD holds rights and owns the water — reducing dependency on others

To be constructed, owned, operated and maintained by UTRWD

\$490 million dollars to build the project



Total project size is approximately 16,000 acres, including environmental improvement areas

180,000 acrefeet of water can be stored in the lake (approximately 58.7 billion gallons)

54 million gallons can be withdrawn daily (on average)*

32 miles (approximately) of new 54–60 inch diameter pipeline to deliver water for treatment

Lake surface area is approximately 7,600 acres, or just under 12 square miles

Providing recreational opportunities, such as fishing, boating and nature watching
