

## Composition requirements to ensure diversity across athletes and sports

The Commission strives to represent a broad range of athlete interests, and therefore must meet specific criteria in its composition:

- No more than two members can represent any one National Governing Body
- There must be a minimum of two Winter Olympic athletes on the Commission
- There can be no fewer than three athletes of either gender
- At least 8 members must have competed at an Olympic Games within the last 4 years

Any eligible athlete can apply, but only the top six voted athletes who, combined with the existing members, match these criteria, will be elected.

The Commission shall always seek to be diverse and ensure that it reflects and represents the entire Team GB athlete community. At its discretion, the Commission may appoint up to two additional members (at any point) to increase the diversity and representation within the group.

## 2024 Election – specific requirements

Please note that due to the composition of the existing members, only athletes who competed at Tokyo 2020, Beijing 2022, or Paris 2024 are eligible to apply for this year's election. All athletes who have competed since 2012 can vote.

Representatives from the sport of hockey will be unable to stand in the election, as the two NGB spaces are filled by members continuing their terms. Athletes from all other Olympic sports are welcome to apply.
