

Background

Team GB is recruiting for the Milan Cortina Olympic Winter Games (OWG) which run from 6th – 22nd February 2026.

We invite practitioners who meet the criteria set out in the job description to send in their CV with a covering letter as an expression of interest to fulfil the role of Chief Physiotherapist for Team GB.

The expression of interest will be open from **Thursday 3**rd **October – Sunday 3**rd **November 2024**. The selection process will consist of:

- Short list selection via CV and cover letter
- 1st Round of interviews to be held on **18th November 2024**
- 2nd Round interview (if required) may be scheduled for early December 2024
- Interviews will take place in London at the offices of The British Olympic Association, 101 New Cavendish Street, W1W 6XH, or remotely via Microsoft Teams. Format to be advised.
- Appointments will be announced in December 2024.

Candidates must ensure that they are available to meet the requirements of fulfilling the allocated job role, including all necessary dates in the build-up to, and during the OWG.

Application Process

- Application processes and job descriptions will be placed on a variety of different websites as well as being circulated to all Home Country Sports Institutes (HCSI).
- Before applying, the candidate should secure clearance from their appropriate line manager (HCSI & National Governing Body [NGB]).
- HCSI employees that are core funded will be released to undertake their duties on HCSI time on the proviso that their usual duties can be covered in their absence.
- NGB employees must gain clearance from their sport in advance of applying for an HQ role, with an understanding that if successful they may not be available to work with their sport at the OWG's.
- When applying please state clearly your HCSI full-time equivalent status and whether your role is core funded or NGB funded.
- External candidates (non-HCSI) are invited to apply on an equal basis, and each application will be considered on its merits.
- It remains an individual's responsibility for those who are not full-time HCSI employees to account for their non-HCSI time.
- Transparency with employees over the time commitment for the role is essential.
- For external candidates (non-HCSI) where paid secondments are not applicable, we would welcome a discussion to understand individual circumstances and availability. In line with BOA policy, all costs relating to kit, travel to and from Italy, and accommodation while in country, along with reasonable additional expenses will be covered.


