Thought starters

- ★ How will my thumbnail stick out from the rest?
- ★ What's the first thing I want people to be drawn to?
- ★ Am I utilising the space?
- ★ What is my colour palette?



Important: If you do include text, please try and avoid using a repetition of the title as this will be displayed underneath your thumbnail.

Use of large overlaid text can make a bold statement (*but no more than a few words!*)



File type: JPEG **Size:** 550px width and 309px height Use contrasting colours and drop shadows to make images and text pop.

Layer up your thumbnail with textures/shapes and patterns Screen-grabbed images can be more captivating than posed headshots.
