# **Build Day Projects**

The Vision is Yours engaged community partners in Mount Rainier in pursuit of high priority projects in public spaces, while offering forum attendees valuable hands-on implementation experiences.

In partnership with the Mount Rainier Elementary School PTO, the Mount Rainier City Council, and Joe's Movement Emporium, and in collaboration with local neighbors along Bunker Hill Road and businesses along 34th Street, our team organized build-day activities around three community Legacy Projects.

Each of the legacy projects advanced components of Mount Rainier Elementary Schools Sustainable Campus Toolkit, which was developed by the school in 2019 in collaboration with an NDC pro bono design team.

Additionally, the surface mural reflected community engagement and visioning conducted by the Mount Rainier City Council and NDC in 2024—modeling low-cost, high-impact design interventions for safer streets and welcoming community gathering space.



#### **Native Pollinator Garden**

Invasive removal, native planting and low-maintenance greening to beautify the Mount Rainier Elementary School Reading Garden while contributing to local ecology.



### **Creative Seating**

Establishing an inviting environment and improve the functionality of the reading garden for teachers, students, and other visitors.



## **Art in the Right of Way**

Demonstration mural on Bunker Hill Road across from Joe's Movement Emporium to build momentum, buy-in, and community feedback for a permanent traffic-calming artwork to improve safety conditions for pickup during after school programs.
