While the digital portion of the program fosters interaction across time zones, the key in-person residencies in Paris, Cape Town, and Hong Kong provide cross-cultural business perspectives, global networking opportunities, and real-world business insights.

True to ESSEC's values, the new Hybrid EMBA will train leaders that have a positive impact on the world. To that end, sustainability considerations are integrated into the program's curriculum, the Social Class Project and the international residency in Cape Town.
