

PROGRAM AT A GLANCE

- **Duration:** 3 weeks from the 30 June - 18 July 2025
- Language of teaching: English
- Course Load: 90 contact hours
- Credits awarded: 9 ECTS
- **Schedule:** Classes Monday to Friday - 9:00 AM to 12:00 PM / 1:30 PM to 4:30 PM / 4:30 PM to 6:00 PM
- **Level:** Undergraduate students
- **Teaching methods:** Case studies, lectures and group work with a high level of class interaction.
- **Location:** ESSEC Africa Campus - Plage des Nations -Sidi Bouknadel (RABAT)

PRESENTATION OF THE MODULE

This 3-week intensive program is designed for undergraduate students interested in African cultures and African business perspectives. The main objective of this immersive program is to give participants key skills to understand the main challenges and specifics of doing business in/with Africa. Students will meet and interact with local experts and professionals who will help them understand the diversity of African business and entrepreneurial practices. They will also visit local companies and associations.

Overview of some courses taught in the program

SURVIVAL MOROCCAN ARABIC	This interactive course introduces students to Moroccan Arabic (Darija), focusing on conversational skills and cultural context. Alongside language lessons, participants will enjoy a hands-on cooking session, where they'll learn to prepare traditional Moroccan dishes.
TANGIER CULTURAL VISIT	This visit is part of the course Introduction to Arabic Muslim Culture. The professor, alongside local guides, will take you on a tour past many of the cities' cultural and historic \$highlights. You'll visit the narrow streets of the medina, different museums, the mysterious caves from Hercules and much, much more.
ENTREPRENEURSHIP & STARTUPS IN AFRICA (3 ECTS) + LEARNING EXPEDITION CASABLANCA	The purpose of this course is to introduce participants to entrepreneurship and innovation. Though it is a global phenomenon, students should grasp the cultural and regional differences especially in an African context: it's not Africa but Africas. This module is based on presentations, case studies, experience sharing sessions with entrepreneurs and includes a Learning Expedition to Casablanca.
INTRODUCTION TO ARABIC MUSLIM CULTURE (2 ECTS)	This course explores the rich tapestry of Arabic Muslim culture, examining its history, traditions, and contemporary expressions. Students will engage with themes such as religion, language, family dynamics, and the arts, gaining insight into the values that shape the lives of millions. Through lectures, discussions, and hands-on activities, participants will develop a nuanced understanding of this vibrant cultural mosaic.
DOING BUSINESS IN AFRICA (2 ECTS)	This course will focus on identifying and discussing the economical contexts and challenges of doing business in Africa. Though the African continent offers huge opportunities, it presents many disparities especially on the fiscal and legal frameworks, without forgetting the unwitten rules that are crucial to understanding the business climate in African countries.
AI & INNOVATION IN AFRICA (2 ECTS)	Artificial intelligence, everyone talks about it but who knows how to seize all the opportunities it offers. This course will enable students to understand the major challenges of AI for the development of new use cases, new businesses and start-ups or simply for general interest.

PROGRAM FEES*

- **Students from partner schools:** 300€ registration and administrative fee to cover class materials, activities and visits.
- Students from partner schools without nomination and free movers (non-partner schools): 1500€ tuition fee+ 300€ registration and administrative fee.
- Students from ESSEC Business School: 1500€ tuition fee

ESSEC AFRICA CAMPUS

ESSEC Africa campus is ideally located on the Plage des Nations site in Sidi Bouknadel in the heart of the Rabat-Salé-Kénitra urban area. It is integrated into a luxury residential area, just a few minutes from the beach and sports and cultural facilities. It is 25 minutes drive from Rabat. and 1h30 from Casablanca.
