



How do I use Atarrus™ for Best Results?


- Apply a total of 16 oz/acre per year on any labeled crop
- Applications can be split up into multiple passes
 - Example: 8 oz/acre with herbicide followed by 8 oz/acre with fungicide
- Greatest response is likely to be under known stress events such as:
 - Spraying soybeans with PPO herbicides
 - Spraying high oil content herbicides on corn during high heat
 - Receiving off sight growth regulator drift from a neighboring field
