

MIXING PROCEDURE

Mix Willowood Clomazone 5G as follows:

- Fill spray tank 1/4 to 1/3 full with water and maintain agitation.
- Add the specified amount of ingredients using the following order:
 - a. Dry formulations (e.g., wettable powders, dry flowables)
 - b. Liquid suspensions (e.g., flowables)
 - c. Liquids (e.g., EC's)
- Mix thoroughly and fill tank 1/2 full and maintain agitation.
- Add Willowood Clomazone 5G to tank and maintain agitation.
- Complete filling the sprayer tank with water.
- If a surfactant is added, add it as the last ingredient to the spray tank.
- Maintain agitation during filling, mixing, and application.
- If using a drift reduction agent, follow specific product label instructions for order of addition to spray tank.
