MIXING PROCEDURE

1. Ensure the sprayer tank is clean and empty
2. Fill 1/2 of the sprayer tank using clean water
3. Add the anti-foaming agent if required
4. With agitation running, add the right amount of Penshui and continue to agitate for 5 minutes
5. Add the Smoke® glyphosate
6. Fill up the tank with water and start spraying

CROP STAGING

Pre-emergence in glyphosate tolerant corn and glyphosate tolerant soybeans + post emergence in glyphosate tolerant corn up to 4 leaf stage
