MIXING PROCEDURE

SPECIAL MIXING ORDER WITH GLUFOSINATE AMMONIUM

- 1. Fill tank half full of water
- 2. Start agitation
- 3. Add required amount of surfactant
- 4. Add FBN Clethodim 240
- 5. Add Glufosinate Ammonium
- 6. Continue agitation and fill tank with water

CROP STAGING

- FBN Clethodim 240 is a systemic herbicide which is translocated from the treated foliage to the growing points of the leaves, shoots and roots. Uptake into the plant is primarily through the leaves. Thorough coverage of the foliage is important for consistent grass control.
- Susceptible grasses that are actively growing will undergo a burn-back and colour change after treatment. Leaf foliage will first change from green to yellowish, then purplish and finally brown colour.
- The time required for complete control is normally 7 to 21 days following treatment, depending on growing conditions and crop competition.
- Apply FBN Clethodim 240 when the annual grasses and volunteer cereals are in the 2 to 6 leaf stage as specified under Application Rates of FBN Clethodim 240. Most effective control is achieved when application is made prior to tillering when annual grasses are small and actively growing.
- For suppression or control of quackgrass, apply FBN Clethodim 240 when the quackgrass is in the 2 to 6 leaf stage and 6 to 15 cm in height. Most effective results are achieved when application is made at the 3 to 5 leaf stage, when the canopy is uniform and actively growing.
