Crop Rotation	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • DO NOT apply FBN QUINCLORAC Herbicide to any field more often than every second year. This practice must be respected in order to avoid potential injury to future rotational crops • Flax and lentils shouldn't be seeded before 20 months of the last application • When applied prior to August 1, barley, canola, oats, peas and wheat (spring, durum, winter) can be seeded the following year • Chemfallow after August 1 and post-harvest: Barley, oats and wheat (spring, durum, winter) can be seeded the following year

MIXING PROCEDURE

1. Fill the clean spray tank half full of water and start agitation
2. Continue agitation throughout the mixing procedure.
 - FBN QUINCLORAC plus glyphosate: Add FBN QUINCLORAC, then glyphosate
 - FBN QUINCLORAC plus Glufosinate Ammonium: Add Glufosinate Ammonium, then FBN QUINCLORAC
 - With Clethodim herbicide: add adjuvant, Glufosinate, FBN QUINCLORAC, and then Clethodim
3. Continue agitating while adding the remaining amount of water.

CROP STAGING

- Spring barley: 1-4 leaf stage (prior to tillering)
- Wheat (spring and durum): 1-5 leaf stage
- Canola (all varieties, including conventional, glyphosate-tolerant, glufosinate tolerant): 2-6 leaf stage
- Canary seed (not to be used for human consumption or fed to livestock): 3-5 leaf stage
