### APPLICATION TIMING

For suppression of Fusarium Head Blight in wheat, apply when at least 75% of the heads on the main stem are fully emerged, to when 50% of the heads on the main stem are in full flower. Application at this time will also control the listed leaf diseases.

For suppression of Fusarium Head Blight in barley, apply when 70 - 100 % of the heads on the main stem are fully emerged, to 3 days after full head emergence.

In Oats apply as a preventative spray when the earliest leaf disease symptoms appear on the leafs and stems.

### APPLICATION TIMING

- FBN PROTEB 250 Fungicide must be applied with properly calibrated, clean equipment.
- Prior to adding FBN PROTEB 250 Fungicide to the spray tank, ensure that the spray tank is thoroughly clean.
- Add one-half of the required amount of water to the spray or mixing tank and start agitation.
- Add the required quantity of FBN PROTEB 250 Fungicide to the water and complete filling with water to the required total volume.
- Maintain agitation throughout mixing and spraying.
