- FBN Clethodim 240
- Facet L[®] contains quinclorac, the active ingredient in FBN Quinclorac

MIXING PROCEDURE IF ADDING FBN CLETHODIM

1. Fill half the tank with water
2. Add WOC adjuvant that comes with Clethodim and start agitation
3. Add the right amount of FBN Glufosinate 150 SN
4. Add the right amount of FBN Clethodim
5. Add the remaining amount of water and try to spray out right after

FOR BEST RESULTS

Try to spray when it is sunny and RH% is higher than 40-50%. Spraying under cloudy, low RH% or dry conditions may reduce weed control.

CROP STAGING

In Canola apply FBN Glufosinate 150 SN from the cotyledon stage up until but prior to the bolting stage of canola.
