

- 1. Special attention is called to the following Calgary Stampede rules and regulations for all equine competitions:
 - a. **General Rules**
 - b. **Health Regulations**
 - c. <u>IAFE code of ethics</u>
 - d. Animal Care Codes of Practice
- 2. Order of the round will be decided by draw on **Tuesday**, **July 9**, **2024 at 12:00 noon**.
- 3. The competition will consist of one round.
- 4. Awards will be presented at the end of each class on **Thursday**, **July 11**, **2024**. All prize monies will be mailed to the owner of the horses entered in Canadian Funds.
- 5. Competitors are requested to travel together as much as possible to reduce the number of trailers/parking.
- 6. The Horse, Rider and Owner must be declared at the time of entry. Rider and Owner must be members of the NRCHA, NRCHA rules will be in effect. This competition is open to horses of any breed registry and non-registered/grade horses.
- 7. Competitor accreditation will be available for pick up upon arrival on July 11, 2024 at the Nat Christie Gate entrance off 25 Ave SE to the show grounds. For alternative pick-up or delivery arrangements please call (403) 261-0162.
- 8. There will be a zero tolerance of any inhumane treatment of horses or cattle while in the show arena or on the show grounds. Any such action will be cause for disqualification. Inhumane treatment includes, but is not limited to, excessive jerking, pulling, kicking, slapping or whipping.
- 9. All complaints and protests will be handled in compliance with the NRCHA rule 14.3.
- 10. If an entry is cancelled, all fees will be forfeited.
- 11. The decision of the Western Performance Horse Committee is final.
- 12. Non Pro riders must comply with the NRCHA ownership rules 2.4.
- 13. **Please note there will be NO unauthorized persons allowed in the Hitching Ring or Warm Up Arena. Exhibitor Badges must be visible at all times, no exceptions will be made. **
- 14. No open alcohol will be permitted in the parking area.
