Topic

Target group

Priority will be given to **online courses, with a special focus on self-paced trainings**. Blended or synchronous trainings can be considered, provided they have a high frequency of recurrence.

To make the Catalogue as accessible as possible, we want to give priority to free trainings. We also accept courses that can be audited for free. Trainings for a fee can also be included, provided information on associated fees, start dates, and essential requirements to participate, is included.
