Dogs can suffer from sunburn too, leading to irritation, hair loss and potential skin cancers. Use a specifically formulated sunscreen for dogs to avoid health risks and apply to:



Reapply throughout the day, especially after water play.

Can't find a pet-formulated sunscreen? Use an SPF 15 or higher sunscreen for babies and children; make sure it doesn't include these toxic ingredients:

- Fragrance
- Zinc oxide
- PABA

Types of skin cancer in dogs associated with sun exposure: squamous cell carcinoma, malignant melanomas, hemangiomas and hemangiosarcomas.

Dogs with short hair, light skin and/or fur or hair are at higher risk of sun damage.
