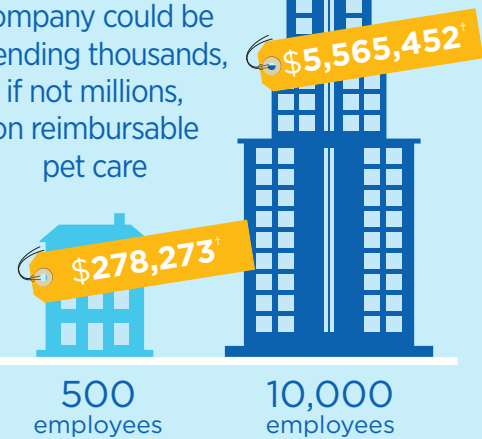

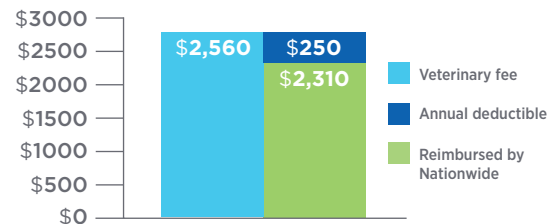
Average monthly **cost**
