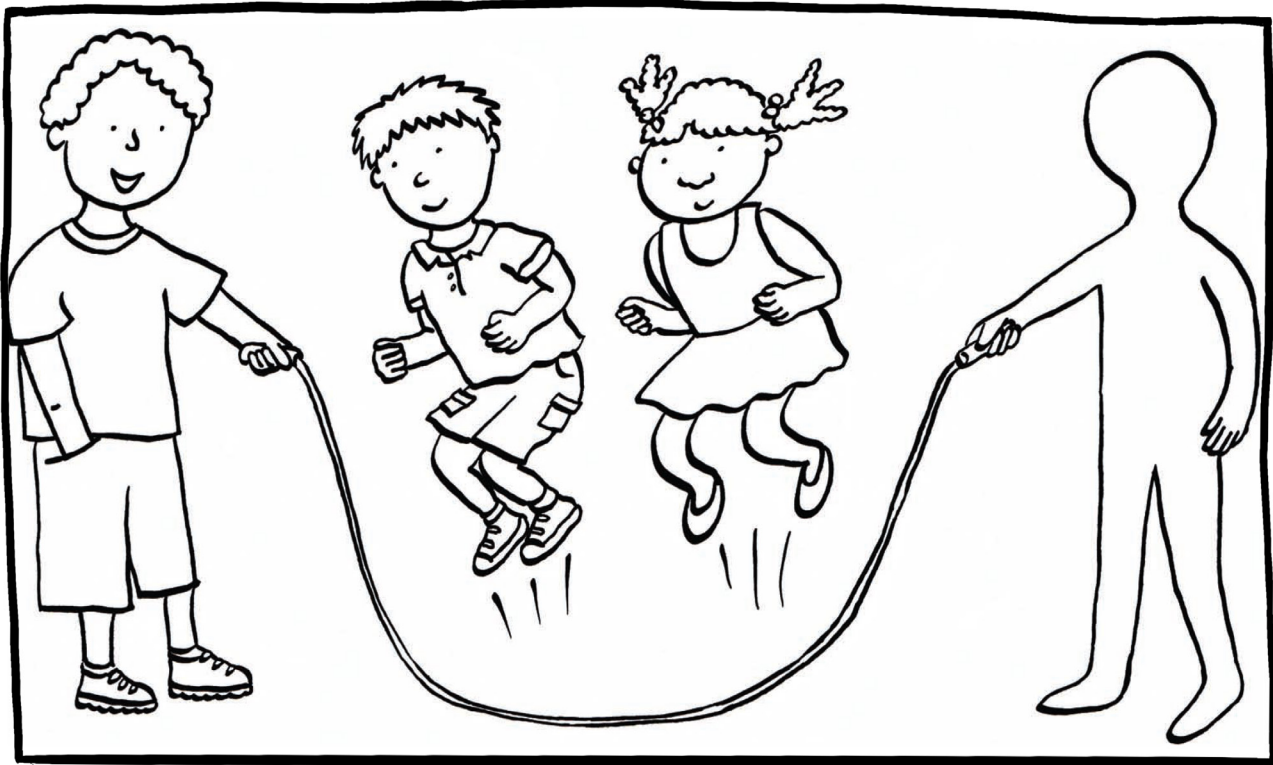


# Sixth Sunday of Easter
