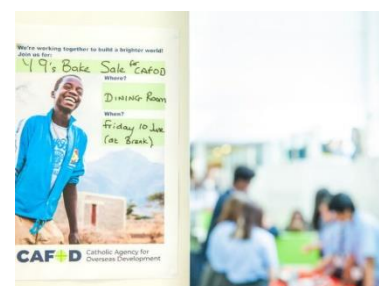
Opportunities to live out Catholic Social Teaching
