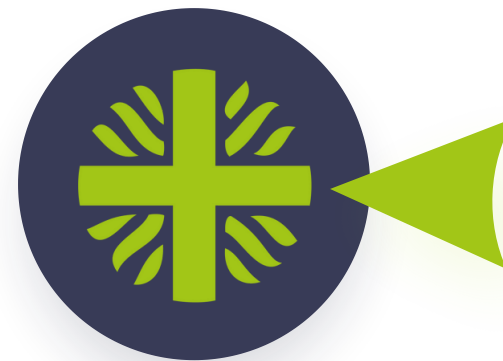
CAFOD stands for the Catholic Agency for Overseas Development.

1962 CAFOD officially set up

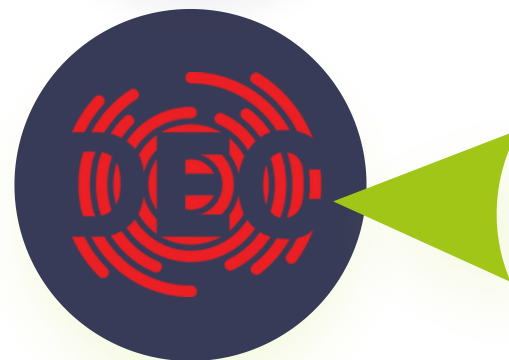
We work in around 30 different countries in Africa, Latin America and the Caribbean and Asia.

Debt, finance and economic justice

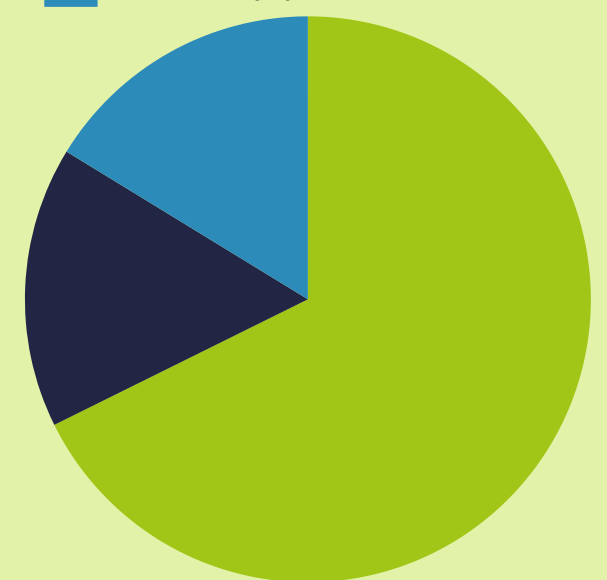
