
Loaves and fishes paper chains

Just as Jesus fed more than 5,000 people, we are encouraged to work towards a world where all people have enough healthy food to eat.


Make some loaves and fishes paper chains to remind you of this miracle.

What you will need: A4 paper, scissors, colouring pens/pencils.


• Cut your A4 paper in half horizontally.



Fold the strip of paper in half vertically.




3. Fold it in half to create a concertina fold



Draw a loaf of bread or a fish.

Make sure the sides of the
drawing touches the edges
of the paper.



so it looks like this



6. Open up your fish or bread! You can decorate them with coloured pencils to brighten then up!

5. Cut out around the outline of your fish or bread. Do not cut along the folds of the paper.
